Green Recovery

Scheme description

A number of reinforcement schemes are planned or are currently underway across NGED's four licence areas as part of the Green Recovery initiative.

This investment is aimed at unlocking network capacity to prevent barriers for customer connections and support the country's net zero ambitions. As these projects are aimed at unlocking capacity critical for net zero and most are already under construction, they are unsuitable for deferral using flexibility.

The following Green Recovery schemes are being progressed on the EHV and 132 kV networks in NGED's four licence areas:
