Sub Station Installs: All the monitoring equipment is now installed in the local sub-stations. This is now capturing all the required data to analyse how your local electricity network is performing.


What's next? The University of Bath is beginning assess the data from all homes and schools to make sure that the system is performing in the most efficient way.
